Julia Yaw, transplant patient of Dr. Kashyap, thanked the surgeon on behalf of herself and her family. During the ceremony, she remarked that because of the life-saving transplant surgery that Dr. Kashyap had performed, she is alive and well today — and she was recently able to go skydiving for the first time.

After receiving the Commendation Award, Dr. Kashyap thanked everyone and in spite of all he has accomplished he credited living and deceased donors and their families as the real heroes. "I don't believe in miracles," **Dr. Kashyap stated.** "I depend on them."
