This week, I was pleased to announce with Attorney General Letitia James that the Doral Arrowwood workers, who were terminated on Christmas Eve nearly two years ago, are receiving \$2.7 million owed to them for violations of the WARN Act. I thank [New York State Attorney General](#) Letitia James, [New York State Department of Labor](#) Commissioner Roberta Reardon and Jane Lauer Barker Esq., who worked tirelessly on behalf of the employees.

In the coming weeks, I will be hosting a number of events including a virtual roundtable on the Landlord Rental Assistance Program, a virtual forum on preparing for retirement, a Thanksgiving Food Drive with Senator Pete Harckham in Mount Kisco and a Narcan training with Central Park Recovery.
