(Hempstead, NY) — The American Red Cross of Greater New York and Senator Kevin Thomas (D-Levittown) recently installed free smoke alarms in constituents' homes in Hempstead to raise awareness and educate residents on the importance of emergency preparedness during the holiday season. The alarms were installed as part of an ongoing partnership between American Red Cross and Senator Thomas to End Home Fires by providing live-saving smoke alarms free-of-charge to Long Island residents.
