

Senator Hinchey's Office Delivers Over 4,000 Valentines to Area Nursing Homes as Part of Second Annual Valentines for Seniors Card Drive

ALBANY, NY – State Senator Michelle Hinchey (SD-46) and members of her Constituent Services Team visited area nursing homes and long-term care facilities in Albany, Greene, Montgomery, and Ulster counties to deliver Valentine's Day cards created by students and community members in the 46th Senate District as part of the Senator's second annual Valentines for Seniors Card Drive.
