García DeLeón had served as the Senior Constituent Liaison and excelled in delivering efficient and effective solutions for constituents dealing with issues with state government agencies.

Pascale Jean-Gilles, JD adds the title of Policy Advisor to her work currently as Director of Outreach. Jean-Gilles has her Juris Doctorate and previously worked as a law clerk for a New Jersey Criminal Court Judge, before returning home to her native Rockland County to serve in the NYS government on Assemblymember Ellen Jaffee’s team prior to joining Senator Reichlin-Melnick’s office last year.

Marcello Figueroa who had served as the senator’s Legislative Director has taken a position with the Westchester County Board of Legislators. Brendan Cahill who served first as 

District Representative and most recently as a Senior Assistant, is moving on to a position in the private sector.
