Teachers may also submit students' artwork to Addabbo's website.

"With the Thanksgiving holiday right around the corner, now is usually the time of year where we look back on what we have done throughout the year what we have to be thankful for," Addabbo said. "I want to encourage the students in my district to let their creativity flow and show us — either in words or a piece of artwork — what qualities they possess that they are thankful for. Everyone has qualities that they can be proud of, whether that is being good at sports, getting good grades, or helping out around your community, and we are looking to celebrate all of our great qualities. Teachers and students can submit their works of art directly to my website, and all works submitted will be featured on my webpage for all to see. Let's show everyone what we are thankful for this year!"
