SYRACUSE – Senator John W. Mannion (SD-50) today released the following statement:

“Micron could have gone anywhere in the world to invest \$100B and create nine thousand jobs - but it chose Central New York and the 50th Senate District for a reason. We have the history, the moxie, and the determination that's needed to transform our economy into a global leader in semiconductor manufacturing.

A successful and coordinated effort across federal, state, and local government was instrumental in securing a deal. President Biden and Senator Schumer made the federal Chips and Science Bill a reality and New York State and Governor Hochul did our part by passing and signing my Green Chips legislation.
