Skoufis Distributes Thanksgiving Meals to 100 Families

Senator James Skoufis (D-Hudson Valley) joined forces with TD Bank, the Hudson Valley Food Bank, and four other local nonprofits to get Thanksgiving meals into the hands of 100 Orange County families in need this week.

Beginning with a community canned goods drive, Skoufis' team gathered nonperishables at their Newburgh office and several TD Bank locations throughout Orange County. TD also sponsored the purchase of 100 turkeys, which were then stored and transported by the Hudson Valley Food Bank before being distributed at the Senator's giveaway event in Middletown on Tuesday. RECAP, HONOR, ABCD, and Jewish Family Services each identified 25 families most in need for the holiday distribution.
