

O'Mara blasts move by Albany Democrats to raise legislative pay

Elmira, N.Y., December 20—State Senator Tom O'Mara (R,C-Big Flats) today blasted legislation introduced last night by the Democrat majorities in the Senate and Assembly to make New York the highest paid Legislature in the nation.

If approved, the legislation, which will be voted on in a special session Thursday and would take effect on January 1, would increase legislators' base pay from the current \$110,000 to \$142,000.

O'Mara released the following statement:

"One-party, all-Democrat control of New York State government continues to show no shame. New York is the highest taxed state in America and Albany Democrats think they deserve to be the highest paid legislators in America?
