New additions to the Senator's staff are Communications Director Tyler Clemons, Director of Constituent Services Charles Potter who will be based out of the Johnstown office, and Legislative Director James Corl who will be holding the fort down in Albany. Finally, Senator Walczyk is happy to have retained Bonnie Fikes as Office Manager. Bonnie was a staple in former Senator Ritchie's office and will be the first smile you come across when visiting the Watertown District Office.
