

Stec Announces More Than \$12 Million in Funding for Ticonderoga, Waddington

Senator Dan Stec (R,C-Queensbury) today announced that two communities in the 45th
Senate District will be receiving a total of \$12.25 million in state funding. As part of New York
State's Downtown Revitalization Initiative, Ticonderoga will be receiving \$10 million. The
Village of Waddington will be receiving \$2.25 million from the state's NY Forward program.

these small, rural communities.
