WHEREAS, In 2003, Troy Jackson Sonesta graduated from John Jay College of Criminal Justice with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice and a minor in Security Management; and

WHEREAS, With a steadfast and unwavering commitment to his community, Troy Jackson Sonesta became a Master Mason in 2005 with Silver Lake Lodge No. 59 of the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge for the State of New York; he served as its Worshipful Master from 2015 to 2016, and became District Deputy Grand Master of the 2nd District, covering 3 lodges in Brooklyn and Staten Island, in 2017; he became a Grand Trustee for the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge for the State of New York in 2022; and

WHEREAS, A Noble in Abu Bekr Temple No. 91 since October of 2016, Troy Jackson Sonesta currently serves as its 72nd Illustrious Potentate, the esteemed position he has held since his election in December of 2022; and
