WHEREAS, Firefighters such as Chief Dennis Fields unwaveringly serve our great State with pride, valor, and integrity; this extraordinary man's leadership and willingness to step up throughout his career has truly set an example to be emulated by all; and

WHEREAS, Chief Dennis Fields is the epitome of the phrase "Living a Life of Service"; the City and its Fire Department owe the Chief a debt
