Senator Kavanagh is working to support seniors in our Lower Manhattan communities and wants to make sure you are aware of resources that may be helpful to you. Please contact our office if you have any questions or need assistance!



Senator Kavanagh is working to improve the quality of life for seniors.



Senator Kavanagh helped enact legislation and a State Budget to:

- Increase funding for the State Office for the Aging by \$30
 million, including more support for Naturally Occurring
 Retirement Communities (NORCs) and State efforts to prevent
 elder abuse.
- Provide grants to local senior centers in Lower Manhattan.
- Eliminate insulin co-payments for most health insurance plans.
- Stop hospitals from suing patients with low- or moderate-incomes for medical debts.
- Provide tougher oversight of nursing homes when their operators want to close them, legislation Senator Kavanagh and Assemblymember Harvey Epstein passed in response to a local nursing home closure (S.2984, awaiting the Governor's signature).
- Automatically enroll seniors in the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) if they already receive Elderly Pharmaceutical Insurance Coverage (EPIC), to make it easier for seniors to get help with energy bills (S.8760A, awaiting the Governor's signature).

As the Housing Committee Chair, Senator Kavanagh negotiated **funding for more senior and supportive housing** and a **new law to protect New Yorkers from being evicted without good cause** (NYS Budget SFY 2024-25). He is working to expand the **Senior Citizen Rent Increase Exemption** (SCRIE) and **Senior Citizen Homeowners' Exemption** (SCHE) programs, to help keep housing affordable for more seniors (S.2960A).
