NYS Senator Dean Murray Appointed to Key Committees and Task Force for 2025 Legislative Session

(Patchogue, NY) – The NYS Senate Republican Conference has released its Committee and Task Force assignments for the 2025 legislative session and Senator Dean Murray has been named the Minority Ranking Member of the Senate's *Commerce, Economic Development, and Small Business Committee*, the *Libraries Committee*, and the *Social Services Committee*.
