A. Introduction

We write this testimony to encourage the Governor and State legislature to continue with its commitment under the recently enacted SIGH Act to ameliorate the harm of chronic over-exposure of air pollution to students who attend schools within 500 feet of major roadways pursuant to the Environmental Bond Act.¹ Funding from the Bond Act should be used to retrofit, upgrade, or install air ventilation systems to the 375 impacted schools that serve mostly Black and Latine students.

The New York State Constitution extends children both the right to a “sound basic education”² and a “healthful environment.”³ Neither can be fully realized when students are forced to learn in environments that compromise their health and wellbeing. In New York, approximately 211,983 students attend public, and charter schools located within 500 feet of highways where they are exposed daily to dangerous levels of air pollution.

This toxic exposure is not distributed equally as 80% of affected students are children of color, and 66% are economically disadvantaged.⁴

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, National Institute of Health, and Center for Disease Control have repeatedly warned against placing schools within 500 feet of major roadways.⁵ Long-term exposure to air pollution from traffic has been associated with an increased risk of developing asthma in children. Because students spend over 1,200 hours in school, frequently during peak travel times, they may experience even more exposure to traffic related pollution than they do at home.⁶ The impacts of air pollution can be life long and ultimately impact children’s cognitive development.⁷ There is ample evidence that placing schools further than 500 feet from major highways and proper ventilation improve academics and decrease chronic absenteeism.⁸ Children of color, especially those who are Black and Latino overwhelming are the population of students who suffer from their schools being within 500 feet of major roadways and are overrepresented in the “prevalence, morbidity, and

severity” of asthma⁹ – making mitigation in communities with high proportions of children of color imminent.

The recently enacted Students Impacted by Gross Highways (“SIGH”) Act represents important progress in protecting students by prohibiting the construction of new schools within 500 feet of controlled-access highways.¹⁰ We commend the Legislature and the Governor for this bold step. However, there is more work to be done. The SIGH Act leaves many students unprotected as it only applies to new construction and does not provide for any mitigation of toxic air quality in schools which are currently within 500 feet of a highway.¹¹

The concentration of schools currently near highways in New York presents a stark picture of environmental racism. Analysis conducted by the NYCLU shows that 72 public and charter schools located within 500 feet of highways serve student populations that are over 90% students of color and 90% economically disadvantaged.¹² These schools are predominantly located in urban areas, with the highest concentrations in New York City's boroughs:

**B. Fund Mitigation In Schools Currently Within 500 Feet of a Highway
Through the Environmental Bond Act**

The Environmental Bond Act provides a clear pathway to protect students in existing schools within 500 feet of major highways. Specifically, a minimum of \$200 million of the 4.2 billion of the Bond Act is allocated to reducing air and water pollution in disadvantaged communities. To date, \$100 million of Environmental Bond Act funds have been allocated to the P-12 "Clean Green School Initiative," focusing primarily on clean energy transition rather than air quality mitigation.¹⁴

The Bond Act requires that the Department of Environmental Conservation "make every effort practicable to achieve a goal that forty percent of funds pursuant to this article benefit 'disadvantaged communities.'"¹⁵ The Bond Act defines disadvantaged communities as areas with: (1) Cumulative environmental pollution and other hazards that can lead to negative public health effects; (2) Concentrations of people that are of low income, high unemployment, high rent burden, low levels of home ownership, low levels of educational attainment, or members of groups that have historically experienced discrimination; (3) Areas vulnerable to the impacts of climate change.¹⁶

The mitigation of air ventilation systems in schools that are currently within 500 feet of major roadways aligns with the SIGH Act’s intent and falls squarely within the purview of the Bond Act. The 2024 awards did not address the reduction of air pollution in schools or improvement of ventilation.¹⁷ Under the SIGH Act, the Governor established a new commitment to eliminate the exposure of New York’s students to traffic related pollution. Use of the Bond Act’s funds for mitigation measures ensures that this commitment is realized for all students at risk from traffic related air pollution not just those who will attend newly constructed schools.

Evidence shows that school districts successfully utilize available environmental funds. For example, the Bond Act specifically allocated \$500 million for school bus electrification, and already over 20 school districts and bus companies have accessed these funds, with 250 districts studying electrification.¹⁸ This high rate of utilization demonstrates strong interest from school districts in initiatives that improve their environmental impact on students, teachers, and the surrounding community.


Nearly all of the 375 public and charter schools within proximity to a highway are within communities designated by the DEC as “disadvantaged,” and have high proportions of students of color and students that are “economically disadvantaged.”¹⁹ The Environmental Bond Act provides a clear opportunity to address the environmental justice crisis facing hundreds of thousands of New York students. The Legislature must allocate these funds to protect our most vulnerable students from the well-documented health hazard of highway proximity.
