ELMIRA, N.Y. – Senators Fred Akshar (R-52) and Tom O'Mara (R-58) will visit the <u>Food Bank of the Southern</u> <u>Tier</u> on Nov. 3 to repack New York State produce, tour the Food Bank warehouse and discuss the Farm to Food Bank bill.

Media is invited to arrive at 11 a.m. for the repack activity. The morning's schedule is:

10:30 – Senators arrive; tour with Food Bank staff and representatives from food pantries throughout the Southern Tier *(closed to media)*

11:00 - Volunteer repack activity

11:15 – Media interviews

Both Senators are co-sponsors of the Farm to Food Bank bill, which would give farmers a tax credit for donating produce to food banks and other emergency food providers. The bill passed unanimously in the Assembly and Senate and is now awaiting Gov. Cuomo's signature.

This event is a follow-up to the Sept. 27 press conference held by Assemblymen Phil Palmesano (R-132), Marcos Crespo (D-85) and Francisco Moya (D-39).
