Dear Governor Cuomo:

I am writing to express my strong concerns about the zero carbon renewable energy credits authorized recently by the state's Public Service Commission. While I support the goal of reducing our reliance on dirty fossil fuels, adoption of this standard is resulting in unexpected and higher utility bills for the Long Island families, businesses and local communities I represent.

By one analysis, school districts, local governments and public authorities like the MTA will pay tens of millions of dollars more for electricity. Schools districts that I represent will face as much as \$6 million in higher bills to support nuclear power generators that don't even service our area. These amounts are on top of electric utility rates that are already among the highest in the nation.

As troubling, the PSC has specifically ordered that these charges remain hidden on consumers' electric bills.

The PSC also must take steps to increase on-bill transparency, as well as ensuring that ratepayers, taxpayers and the public are fully informed of ways that revenues from this program are invested to promote cleaner energy and a better environment.

I would welcome the opportunity to work with you to attain these goals.
