The Sands Point Preserve is located on the original Guggenheim Estate and includes a magnificent 216-acre park, including historic mansions and the Phil Dejana Learning Center. The Preserve is owned by Nassau County and is maintained and operated by the Sands Point Preserve Conservancy, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. The Conservancy provides year-round educational and cultural programs, seasonal celebrations, mansion tours, fitness activities as well as private/corporate event services and film/TV location facilities. The estate's mile-long beach along the LI Sound and Hempstead Harbor is the site of numerous educational and wellness programs throughout the year.
