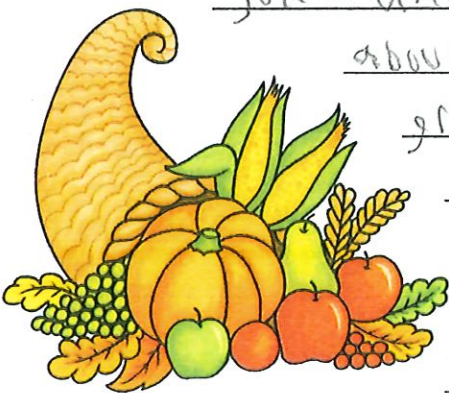


My Thanksgiving

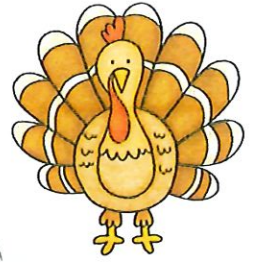
