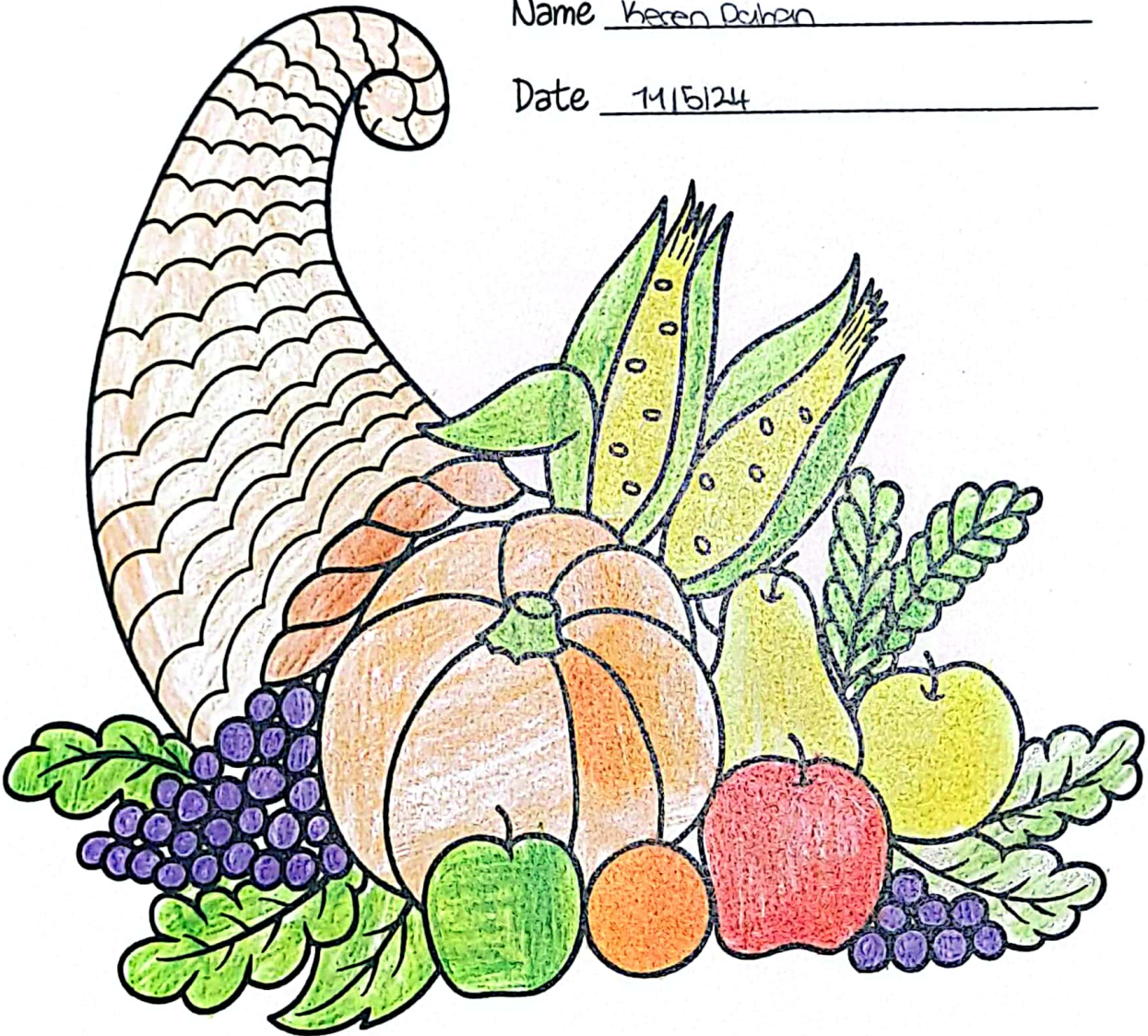


# I'm So Thankful!

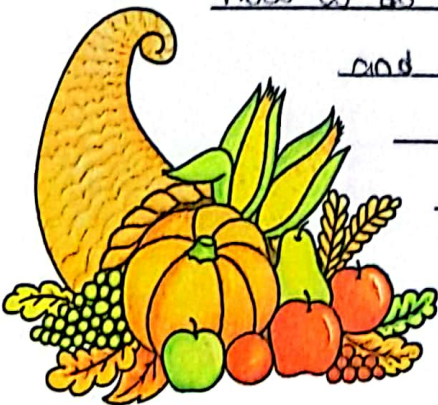


# THANKFUL STORY

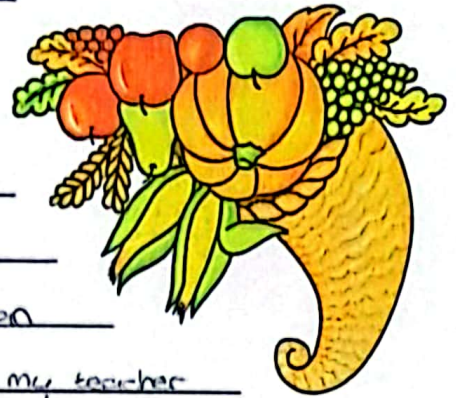
