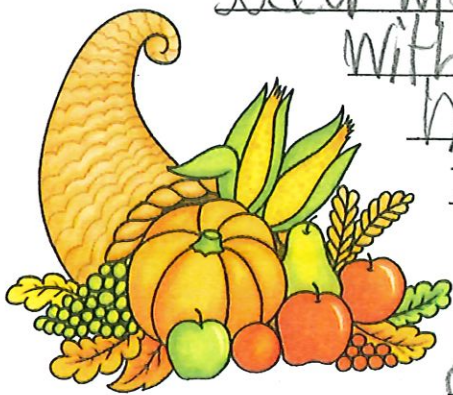


I'm So Thankful!
