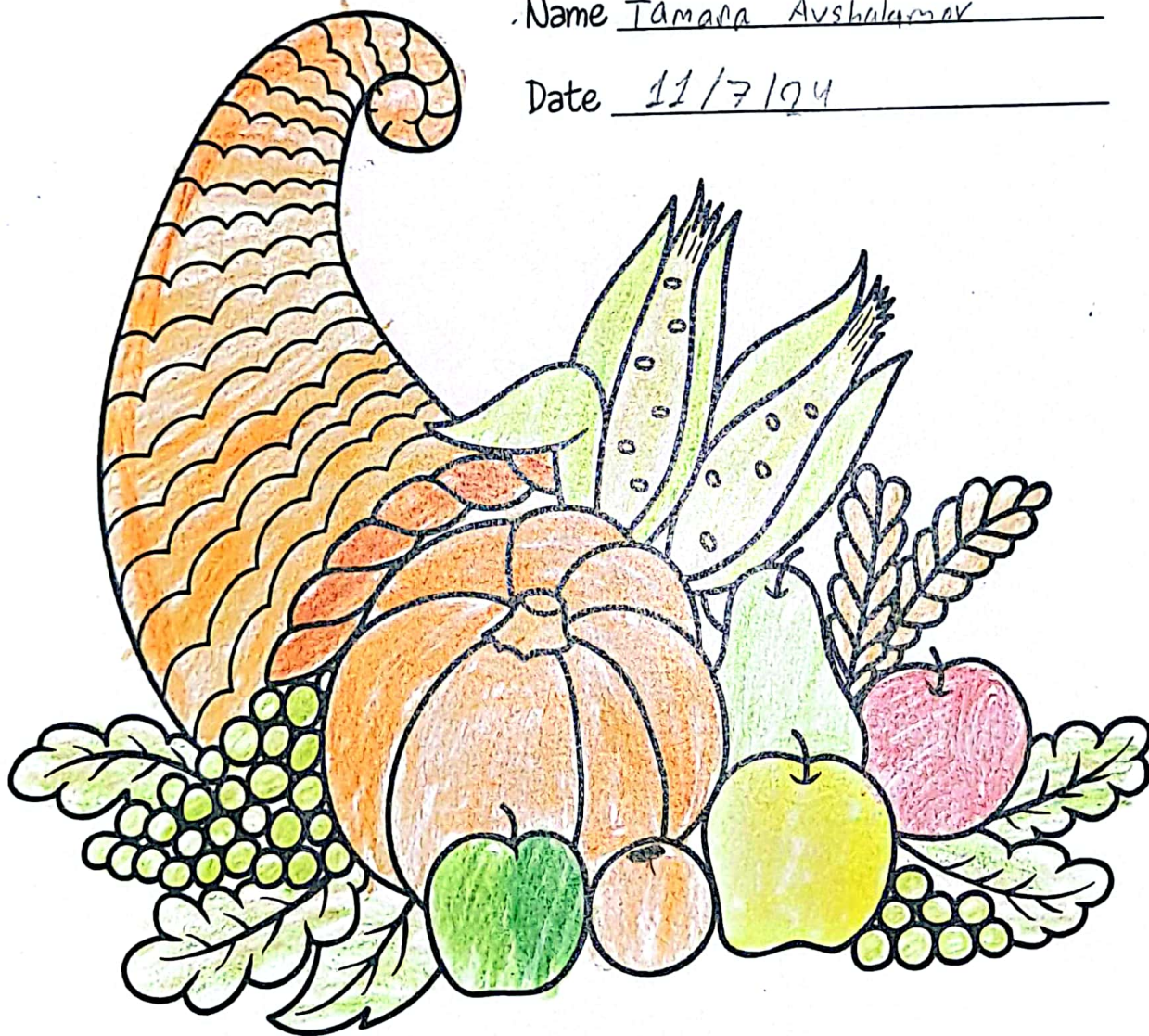


I'm So Thankful!

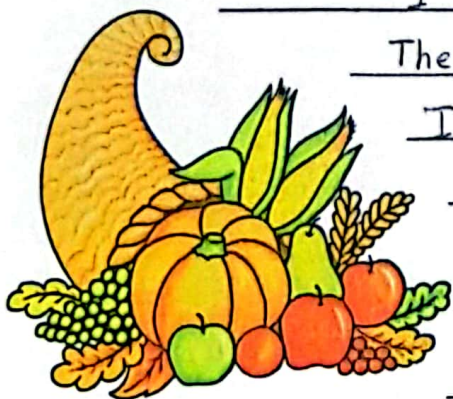


Thanksgiving Fun!

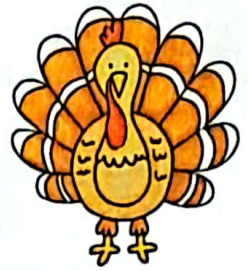
