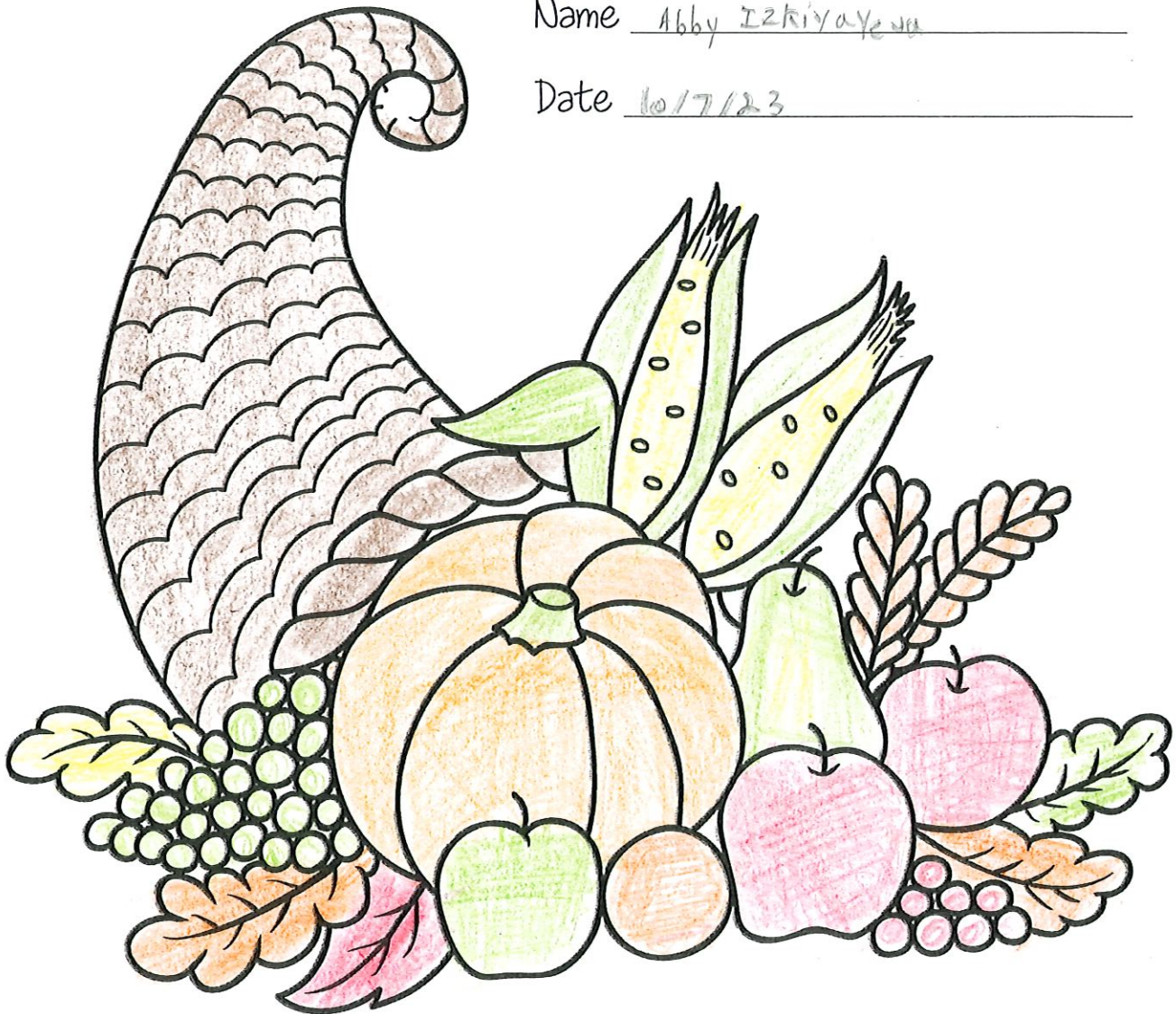


I'm So Thankful!

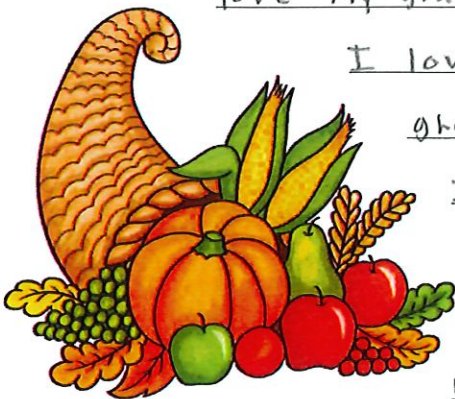
I'm thankful for my mom for buying me toys. I love my mom for taking me to the park. The biggest thing I love about my mom is she takes good care of me.

I'm thankful for my grandma for giving me treats. I

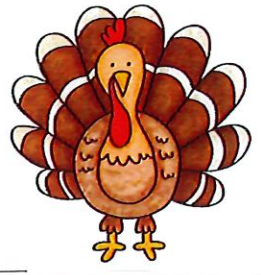
love my grandma for playing with me. The best thing
