This Thanksgiving I am thankful for my family, friends and school.

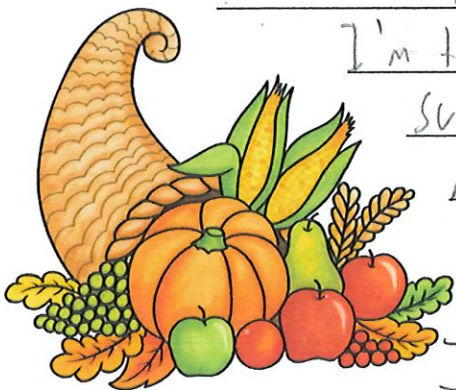
